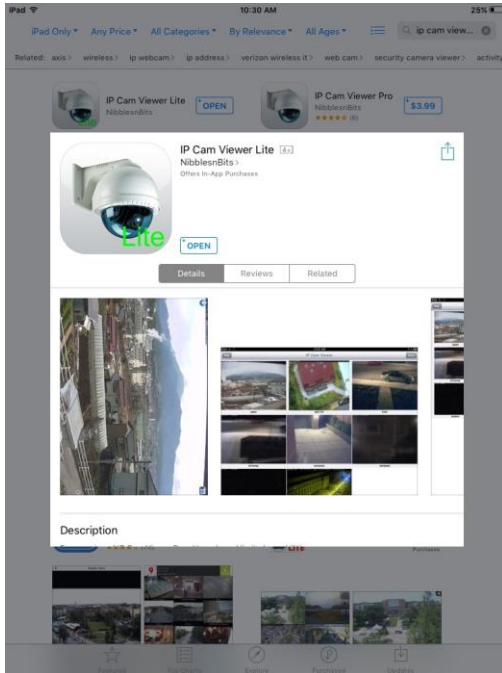



Instructions for the HNC3W and HNC5W on iOS using "IP Cam View Lite"

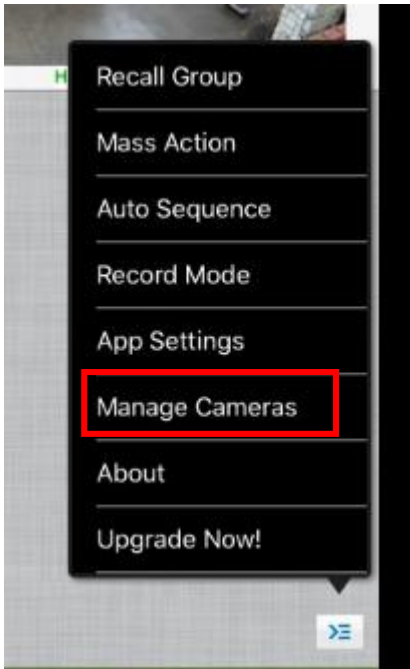
1. Go to App Store and search for and install "IP Cam Viewer Lite" by NibblesnBits



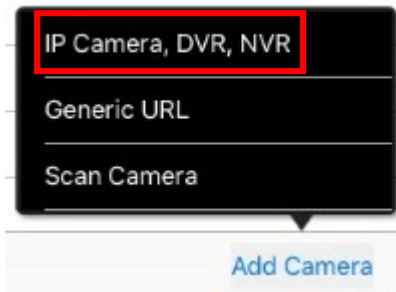
2. Open the App and Click on the  Button



3. Choose Manage Cameras



4. On the Manage Cameras Page, on the bottom, click “Add Camera” and select “IP Camera, DVR, NVR”



5. Name: Type in a Name for the Camera

Type: Choose Fitivision CS1300

IP/Host: Type in the IP Address for the Camera

HTTP Port: the port the device is using (by default can leave it 80)

User: type in the camera user name

Pass: type in the camera password

Click "Save"

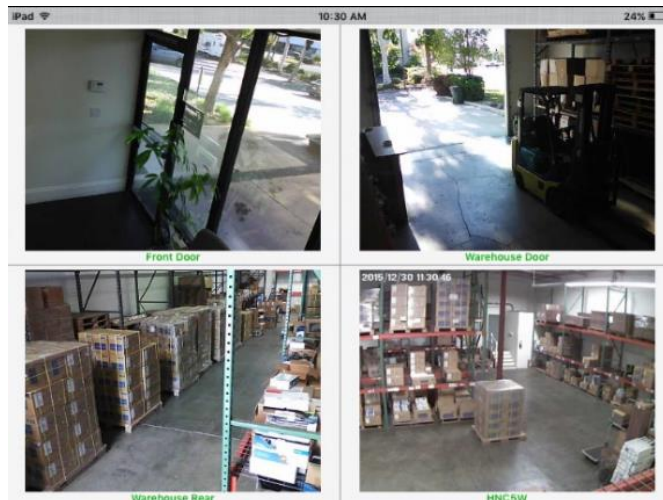

Click 'More Options' to invert pan, tilt, image, etc

6. You should now see a Manage Cameras Page listing the camera you just added. Click "Back" to view your camera's image



7. You should now be able to view the image of the camera you just added.



8. To add more cameras, just redo from Step 2 onward.

Note: this method is to view the camera on your local area network. If you wish to view the images outside your network over the internet, there are a few extra steps

First, you must open the ports the camera uses. By default, the HNC3W and HNC5W both use Port 80. You will open these ports in your router's firewall/port forwarding/virtual server settings. Refer to your router's user manual for these instructions.

After you do that, in Step 4, input your internet's IP Address in the Host/IP field. You can find this in your router's settings (or type in the web browser "whatismyip.com").

You should now be able to view your camera over the internet.
